When you join our Troop you are also making a commitment.

With commitments come expectations and there are certain standards which the Leaders are keen to promote.

For this reason we have a Code of Conduct for all our members and parents are expected to help and encourage their children to maintain this.

If the Leaders feel that members are not making an effort to maintain the Code of Conduct, it may be necessary to review their membership.

- Arrive for meetings on time, in full uniform (unless told otherwise) and be prepared to join in.
- Be intolerant of bullying & swearing and DO NOT do it yourself
- Listen to & follow instructions given by leaders without argument/back chat
- Respect our meeting place, equipment and other people
- Set a good example to others and younger members
- DO NOT swear
- DO NOT be violent in anyway
- Be courteous at all times, manners cost nothing!
- DO NOT litter
- When given badges attach them to your uniform in the correct place as soon as possible
- Talk to the leaders if you are unhappy about anything
- Mobiles SHOULD NOT be brought to meetings or camps unless prior arrangement made with Leaders, in emergency all communication should be made via the Leaders.
- Make every effort to attend Remembrance Day Service and one other service per year
- Help with at least one fundraising activity per year
- Have the courtesy to inform Leaders if you are going to be absent, and try to attend all meetings unless there is a valid reason
- Enjoy your Scouting

We as Leaders are also committed to the Scouts and we promise to:

- Deliver a Balanced Programme, containing at least 2 Challenge Badges and 3 Activity Badges per year
- Maintain the same standards of uniform and behaviour expected from our Scouts
- Listen and respect the views of our Scouts and where possible accommodated their needs
- Make Scouting exciting and fun, whilst ensuring the personal growth and experience of each member.
- Where possible, give prior notice of changes to the programme
